

How to Apply to Salford City College

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Finding a course

1. Navigate to Salford City College Website <https://www.salfordcc.ac.uk>
2. Once on the homepage there are multiple ways of finding our course information

To view all unfiltered courses

2a. Click 'Apply Now' (top right)

-> select '16-18 courses'

2b. Select 16-18 from the Top Menu

-> select 'Courses'

2c. Click Search Course (top right)

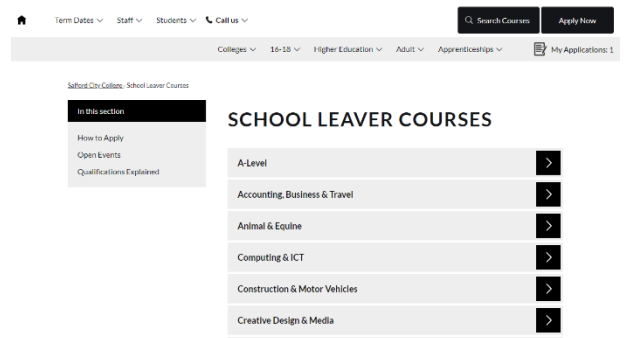
-> Type name of the course you're interested in

ART & DESIGN (A-LEVEL)

With over 100 creative subjects available to study at A-Level, students studying creative subjects have a range of diverse career options. Before they choose their path, they should apply to work in the creative industries but are unsure of the specific direction they want to take at this stage, then this course is for them.

Entry: Year 10 students apply for and gain High Level Access on some of the top creative degree courses in the world at London Metropolitan University, Brunel University, London, London College of Fashion, London College of Art, Chelsea School of Art, Central Saint Martins, London College of Fashion, Brunel University, Manchester Metropolitan University and Leeds College of Art.

Outlines

This course offers students the opportunity to explore a range of creative disciplines from fashion, illustration, painting and drawing through to working in three dimensions, photography and print. This qualification is awarded by University of the Creative Industries, London, awarding their skills in the area of art and design awarding body in the UK and is highly regarded in this country and internationally.

All work is externally moderated to ensure fairness of assessment and that national standards are maintained.

Entry Requirements

Students need to have a grade 5 at GCSE 16/17. Students will need three GCSEs and three GCSEs including a Creative GCSE in English and Mathematics. They should also have a broad range of GCSEs in Art, Design and Technology or a Creative qualification in art and design-related subject. The applicants without a previous qualification in art and design, would need to demonstrate a keen interest in the subject through a creative portfolio.

Adding a course to application

Our online application process works like a basket, you can add up to 4 courses from any area to any one application and then complete an application form for your selected courses.

1. On the List of courses if there are no level options you can add the course directly from the list by clicking the 'Apply' button next to the courses you are interested in eg A-Level.

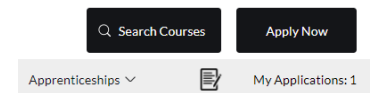

1. Click the 'Next' button at the bottom of the Application courses list

6. Correct any validation that may show
7. Click Next at the bottom of each form to continue
8. After Signature Clicking Next will complete and send the application to the College.
